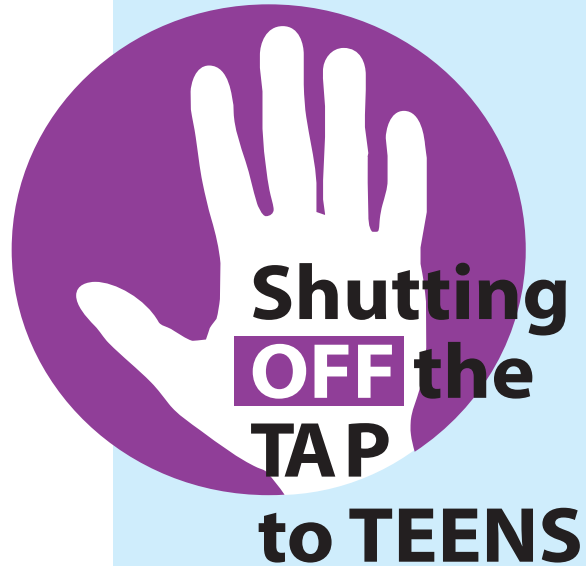

*Reducing Underage Drinking Through Policy Change*

### SPEAKER

Dr. Ed Ehlinger, director, Boynton Student Health Services, University of Minnesota.
