Award Categories

There are five award categories. Choose one category for your nomination.
Please do not nominate the same person for more than one award.

- **Outstanding Individual:** Awarded to a person who has made an outstanding contribution in the field of adolescent sexual health promotion, adolescent pregnancy prevention and/or adolescent parent support.
- **Teen of the Year:** Awarded to a young person(s) who has made an outstanding contribution in the field of adolescent sexual health promotion, adolescent pregnancy prevention and/or adolescent parent support.
- **Advocate of the Year:** Awarded to a policymaker, individual or agency who has provided valuable leadership in support of policies or legislation affecting adolescent sexual health promotion, adolescent pregnancy prevention and/or adolescent parent support issues.
- **Community Partner:** Awarded to someone from outside the field who has contributed to public understanding and dialogue around the issues of adolescent sexual health, adolescent pregnancy prevention and/or adolescent parent support.
- **Program, Collaboration or Agency of the Year:** Awarded to the program, collaboration or agency that has made an outstanding contribution to improving the quality of life for young people around issues related to adolescent sexual health promotion, adolescent pregnancy prevention and/or adolescent parent support.
